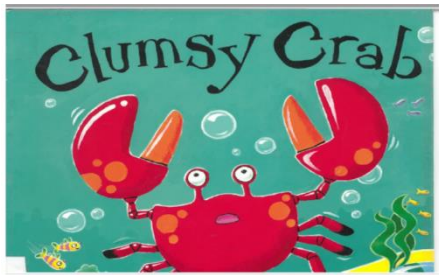
Update

Our learnings last week were based around learning the difference between a ‘fact’ and an ‘opinion.’ We had many a discussion about whether crabs are scary or not! Mrs Lacny is getting more confidence in recording stories with her retelling of Clumsy Crab by Ruth Galloway. We recapped about the names and features of 2D shapes. Say parallelogram 3 times fast!!!
