FINAL STEM/KITCHEN GARDEN SESSION



On Monday 27th March, we dug up our undies that we buried in week. Year 3 students discovered that their 'soil your undies' experiment revealed that the soil near the building in the junior school area was not suitable to plant vegetables. The undies were only wet and dirty with no visible signs of decomposing. Try this at home to see where the best place to plant your vegetable crop should be.


The students from years F/1 and 3 discovered the magic of chemical reactions when an alkali and an acid mix together. We mixed, vinegar, bi-carb soda and hot water with

dishwashing liquid and a drop of food dye. The results were very visual. If you would like to do this experiment at home, the link above has all the instructions.



We also discovered what happens when you put food colouring into a bowl of milk and touch it with a cotton tip dipped in dishwashing solution. The dishwashing solution breaks down the fat in the milk and forces the colours to separate.

The students in year 3 and 4 were investigating the chemical reactions between bi carb soda and vinegar when put together in a bottle. We found out that the reactions cause a gas called carbon dioxide that inflated the balloon. It was amazing! An easy kitchen science experiment to try at home.



This was my last session with the students, I've thoroughly enjoyed developing the scientific minds of the student's, promoting curiosity and investigations.
