KITCHEN SCIENCE

On Monday the 20th March, the year 5/6 students were engaged in Kitchen Science. Whilst the students had lots of fun making ice cream in a bag, they also discovered that when you add salt to ice, the freezing point of milk changes and you can create ice-cream. The students were also engaged in making their own sherbet discovering what ingredients they needed to make sure the sherbet was tingly on the tongue. This experiment was all about chemical reactions and as you can see, they all enjoyed the task.




