I want to assure you that we are taking this situation very seriously, and we are doing everything possible to continue to support our students to have continuity of learning. Thank you for your understanding during this challenging time for school communities.

#### **Library Withdrawal**

This week teachers collectively decided to re-introduce an engagement support measure called Withdrawal. Whilst we have always used this as a support for students, this was usually for a specific need. This process has been communicated with all students. If your child is sent to spend some time reflecting on their choices in Withdrawal, the classroom teacher may decide to contact you via email or phone depending on the context of the situation.



#### **SCHOOL PHOTOS**


