Student Behaviour Expectations:

Sometimes at school there are behaviours that staff need to manage. As we continue to strive to providing a safe and conducive learning environment for our students and staff, I wanted to take a moment to update you on our school's approach to behaviour management. Our behaviour management strategies are designed to promote a culture of respect, responsibility, resilience and cooperation among all members of our school community. We use a tiered response to managing student behaviour – this is a triangle that we have included in this newsletter. This term our staff will be working on a refined Behaviour Management process that is student friendly. We believe clarity is important in defining the steps of behaviour to all students and the wider community. We will communicate this with our families and students once completed.

Contacting Teachers:



Mount Pleasant Primary School Values Awards

This year at Mount Pleasant Primary School we are introducing termly Values Awards. Students will be nominated based on their demonstration of the school values of Respect, Resilience and Responsibility. Teachers will then meet to discuss the nominations and award two recipients – one from the Junior School (Grade F to 2) and one from the Senior School (Grade 3 to 6). The awards will be presented at the last Community Assembly of the Term.

MPPS Values Award Criteria

Respect

Student consistently demonstrates respect toward all teachers, their peers and the school community. Student speaks kindly and with encouragement and treats others fairly. Student supports their peers during learning and social play and takes pride and care of the school grounds and the classroom setting.

Responsibility

Student consistently demonstrates that they are committed to their learning, regardless of their ability and takes responsibility of the choices that they make in the classroom and in the playground. Student cares for their belongings both in the classroom and in the playground and cares for the environment.

Resilience

Student consistently demonstrates a willingness to give things a Red Hot Go! Student takes on feedback from teachers and staff and uses that feedback to grow. Student can bounce back from challenging situations by using strategies that they have been taught, and support others to do the same.

If your child is missing any belongings, please check our lost property at the office. We urge families to please name their school uniforms/lunch boxes so that items brought to the office can be returned to students.








Second hand uniform is currently on sale from the General Office between the hours of 8.30-10.30 each morning and 2.30-4pm in the afternoon.

Sentral e-resource Registering on the Sentral for Parents App for the first time






Step One: Download the Sentral for Parents app.



Step Two: Type in the school's name.




Step Three: Choose 'Register Here' from the bottom of the screen. Complete the details and choose 'Create Account'. You will receive a verification email which MUST be verified to continue. When the verification link is clicked it opens the log in screen in browser – close the browser and go back to the Sentral for Parents app.



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Step Four: Choose your preferences



Step Five: Connect to your child in this screen 'Add Access Key'. The access key is written on the note/email sent to you from the school. It is case sensitive so type it in exactly as it appears in the note/email.



Step Five: You are now connected and can interact with the App.
