### Hats

### World Teacher's Day

Next Friday, 25<sup>th</sup> October, is World Teacher's Day. This day is an opportunity for the community to recognise the fabulous work and dedication our staff at Mount Pleasant Primary School put in each and every day for our students. We are very fortunate to have staff that care so passionately about the school and students, and who go above and beyond to ensure that they provide all possible opportunities for our students.

In the Art Centre, the history group will have more pictures, memorabilia and artefacts on display, joining the members of the Albert Coates Memorial Trust. In the back of the Arts Centre, you will find our Book Fair set up, and at the canteen area there will be tea, coffee and cake.

Planning is also underway for our family fun night on November 7<sup>th</sup>. We ask families to note this date in the calendars and look out for more information to come!

## Uniform and Safety

A gentle reminder to our families that we do expect our students to attend school in full school uniform. Students who are wearing non-uniform items may be asked to remove them – such as hoodies, brightly coloured shirts or other jumpers under their school shirts and jewellery (including fake nails). We take pride in our school community and kindly ask for the support of our families in maintaining a collaborative approach to keeping our uniform standards high.

We have also noticed more students who are not keeping long hair tied back. This is a safety concern as well as a hygiene concern. We ask families to assist us to ensure that all students with shoulder length hair have it neatly tied back. This applied to all students – if the hair touches the shoulders, it must be tied back. Our students are active and have regular PE – untied hair does pose a safety risk.

I thank our families for their support in maintaining student safety and pride in uniforms.

### Breakfast Club Parent Helpers Needed Term 4!

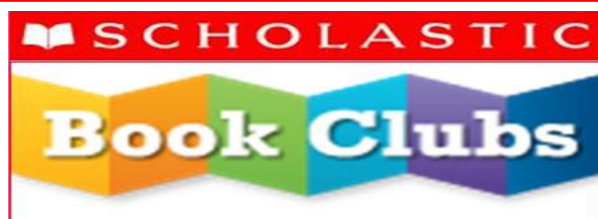
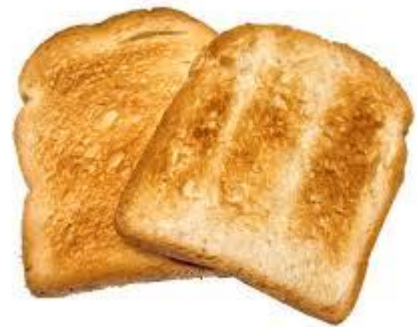
A huge thank you to our wonderful parent volunteers for coming in every day to help with Breakfast Club!

If you are interested, please contact Anna Johnson on 5332 3646. Set up starts at 8.20am and you should be out the door by 9.15am.



### Who receives the School Saving Bonus

The school Saving Bonus is available for parents and carers of all Victorian government school students from Foundation to Year 12 in 2025, except for full-fee international students, home schooled students, TAFE students and students attending kindergarten in 2025.

### Accessing the \$400 School Saving Bonus

You do not need to apply for the School Saving Bonus. The Department of Education will **email you** in November 2024 with your \$400 School Saving Bonus. You will be able to access it via an online system.

### Actions for parents and carers

Parents and carers of children who meet the School Saving Bonus eligibility above are required to do the following **by Friday 18<sup>th</sup> October 2024.**

#### Complete Enrolment

If your child, or children are changing government schools for Term 1 2025, or starting Foundation in 2025, please complete the necessary enrolment process.

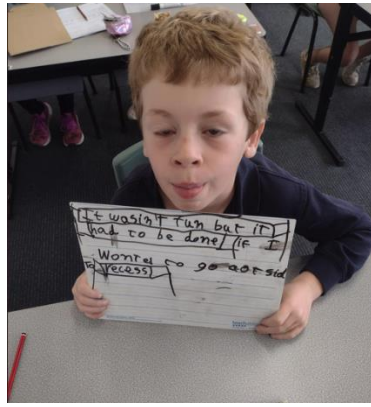
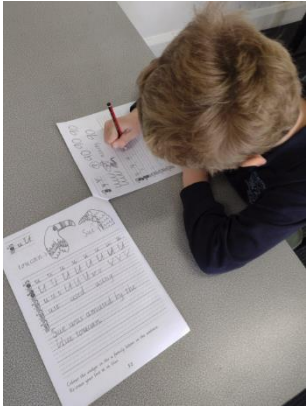
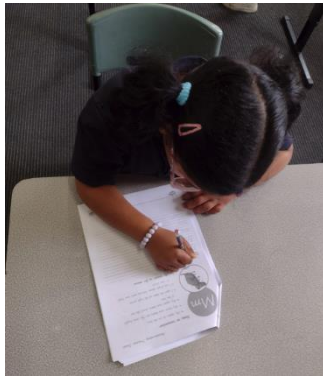
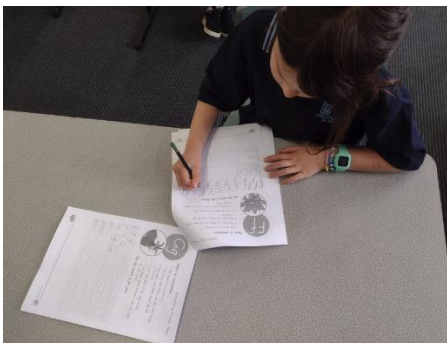
We also worked with 'pizza' and identified decimals, percentages and fractions.

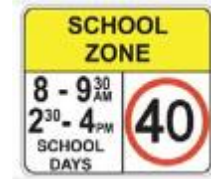

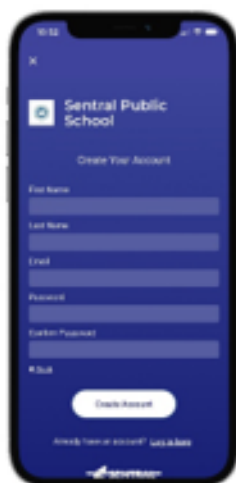
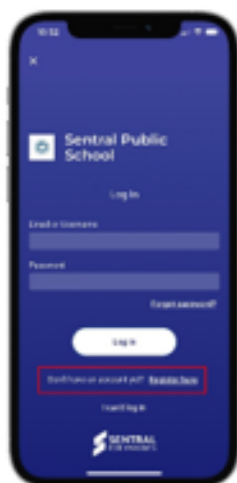
**Step One:** Download the Sentral for Parents app.



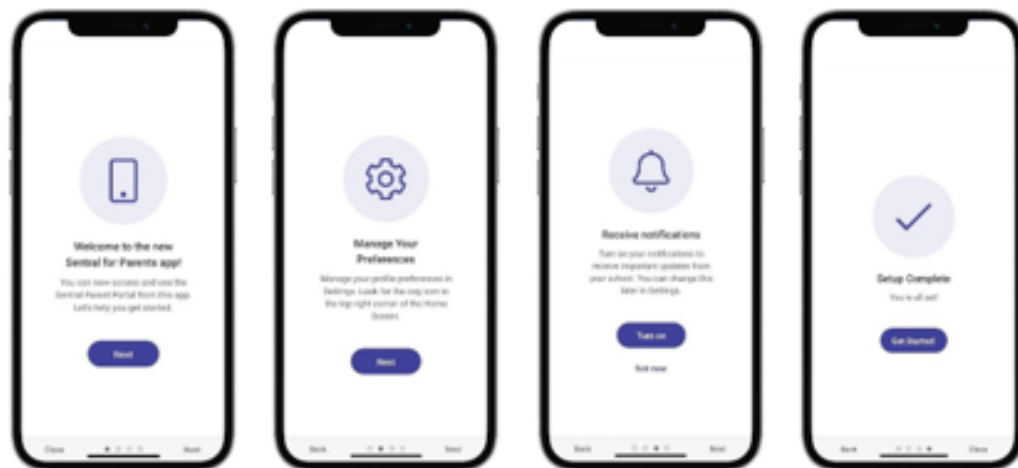
**Step Two:** Type in the school's name.



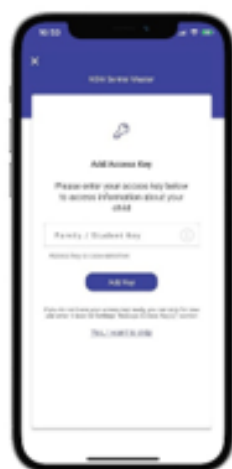
**Step Three:** Choose 'Register Here' from the bottom of the screen. Complete the details and choose 'Create Account'. You will receive a verification email which **MUST** be verified to continue. When the verification link is clicked it opens the log in screen in browser – close the browser and go back to the Sentral for Parents app.



#### Step Four: Choose your preferences



**Step Five:** Connect to your child in this screen 'Add Access Key'. The access key is written on the note/email sent to you from the school. It is case sensitive so type it in exactly as it appears in the note/email.



**Step Five:** You are now connected and can interact with the App.
